SCHOOL OF CHOICE INFORMATION

Rules & Regulations:

1. If the number of applications for a specific grade level or program exceeds the number of available spaces, applicants will be selected through a lottery process and must meet all other Choice requirements.
2. If a sibling of a School of Choice (SOC) enrollee wishes to enroll in Wyandotte Public Schools (WPS) and the District is accepting SOC students in the siblings grade level, the sibling will have priority status for that grade and will not be subject to the lottery. They must meet all eligibility requirements.
3. Students who currently attend Wyandotte Schools and move residency to another city during the same school year (or summer), will have priority status for enrollment and not be subject to the lottery. They must meet all eligibility requirements.
4. There will be no tuition or other enrollment costs associated with SOC students attending WPS other than those costs that are expected of all students attending WPS (instrumental equipment rental, lab fees, etc.).
5. SOC students are expected to adhere to all rules and regulations, the Student Code of Conduct, and policies of WPS. In addition, they must comply with all School of Choice legislative rules and regulations.
6. Once a SOC student is accepted, he/she may maintain enrollment for the remainder of his/her educational career without re-submitting to the SOC process. However, should a specific class become overcrowded, due to increased residential enrollment, or other circumstances deemed necessary by the Superintendent of Schools, SOC and Limited Open Enrollment students, may be required to move to a classroom/school with lower enrollment within the District.
7. Students who have been expelled from any school district and/or school, public or private, are not eligible for enrollment in WPS.
8. Students who have been suspended from any school district and/or school, public or private, within the past two years, are not eligible for enrollment in WPS.
9. SOC students, who enter as a new student in the 10th or 11th grade, will not be eligible for competitive athletics for the first semester of the 2010-11 school year as specified in the Michigan High School Athletic Association regulations.
10. School District transportation is not available for SOC students unless it is a requirement of a student's special education IEP.
11. SOC students who are eligible for special ed. programs will be subject to the same placement procedures as all students attending WPS.
12. SOC students entering Wilson Middle School or Roosevelt High School will be scheduled classes as determined by the school counselor and based on availability.
13. Exact grade level placement for SOC students entering RHS will be based on the student's actual number of credit hours earned.
