Wyandotte has a number of school instruments for temporary use for those with a financial need. It is our primary mission that every child who wants to learn an instrument is given that opportunity, and we are happy to work with your family to make that happen.

Sending in \$25 will allow us to find your child a school instrument to use and take home immediately. © Most of the money goes towards mandatory supplies, which your child is able to keep: a daily instruction book and interactive download or dvd, 2 reeds, valve oil, cork grease, rosin and sponge shoulder rest, depending which instrument they select. A second/final \$25 is due by January 15<sup>th</sup>, which is used to help keep the school instruments repaired and in good working order. The instrument must be returned in June.

Instruments will be distributed on a first come basis – we do our best to give students their first or second choice! Once we receive the initial \$25, we will match the student with an instrument.
