We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 20162017 educational progress for Washington Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability and teacher quality. For the 2016-17 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest $5 \%$ of all schools in the state. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.
At Washington Elementary School we continually assess the growth and progress of our students in math, reading, and language to seek ways to improve. Our students take a NWEA assessment three times a year to track growth and progress. Using these reports, teachers establish individualized goals and instructional plans for our students. The MStep scores have shown low science scores at our school, in the district, and across the state. In an effort to target needs, we added science to our NWEA assessment schedule and have seen an increase in our score. We will be analyzing the M -Step results annually as well to determine trends and needs. Additionally, teachers at Washington Elementary have committed to differentiated educational practices by using a Daily 5 Reading and Math classroom design that balances whole group instruction, small group instruction, and one on one conferring with students.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. School Assignment: Grades Young 5s -5 students residing in the City of Wyandotte are assigned elementary buildings in one of two ways: Area Residency - geographic boundaries have been established around each elementary building taking into consideration city boundaries, major thoroughfares, railroads, and natural boundaries (creeks, rivers). Limited Open Enrollment - parents may apply for their children to attend any District elementary school. Approval for Limited Open Enrollment (LOE) and Nonresident Open Enrollment (CHOICE) attendance depends on space availability in the selected school and previous behavior reports.

Students in grades 9-12 living in Wyandotte enroll at Roosevelt High School; and in grades 6-8 enroll at Wilson Middle School.
2. School Improvement Status: Washington Elementary School staff meets regularly in school improvement committees and believes in the process of continuous improvement. Washington Elementary School has met all the standards for eligibility of a school wide Title I school. Our three academic goal areas have been reading, writing, and mathematics, as well as, an organizational goal.
3. Curriculum: The District has transitioned to the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) as its curriculum. Each school provides learning experiences in all areas of language arts (reading, writing, speaking and listening), mathematics, social studies, and science. Report cards include grade specific standards. Each teacher must plan lessons and learning experiences with the CCSS in mind. All lesson plans must coordinate with the Common Core State Standards. Documents of these standards can be found at www.corestandards.org/. All textbooks and curriculum materials are selected based on these standards.
4. Student Achievement: Student achievement is measured in numerous ways by Washington Elementary Staff. All of our 3-5 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ grade students participate in the Michigan's M-Step tests. In addition, a variety of assessment tools are used to evaluate student progress including, reading fluency and comprehension assessments using Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA) and/or Individual Reading Inventory (IRI), common assessments developed by our teachers to evaluate progress on our school improvement goals, NWEA assessment, and various classroom assessments. Generally, our data shows steady improvement, but a protocol is in place to intervene with small group instruction and remediation when a child doesn't meet expectations or we see a declining trend in a performance area.
5. Parent-Teacher Conference Data: The 2015-2016 school year data shows $96 \%$ of Washington parents attending parent teacher conferences in the fall and spring. The 2016-2017 school year data shows $96 \%$ of Washington parents attending parent teacher conferences in the fall and spring.

The staff, students, and parents of Washington Elementary believe in working together to ensure academic growth and success for our students. The vision of our district and school is strong. I congratulate all the students and stakeholders of Washington Elementary School in the district of Wyandotte for making student growth a priority and committing to academic excellence for our children.
