



***Frequently Asked Questions about  
Return to School 2020-2021  
(responses are based on Phases 4 and 5)***

- 1. If we want face to face/remote do we have to register?**

No, registration is needed.

- 2. What are the differences between WPS(Wyandotte Public Schools) face to face/remote start and WVA(Wyandotte Virtual Academy)?**

WPS face to face/remote start will have live classroom sessions with WPS teachers. The days will be much like a regular school day for your child(ren). The WVA is a module based program. Students will be required to have at least 20 hours of seat time per week and Wyandotte teachers will monitor their progress and make sure their work is being submitted.

- 3. Do you have plans for the orientation for 9<sup>th</sup> graders/parents?**

Yes, orientation will be August 26 from 9-noon.
