WYANDOTTE PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROCEDURES School Visitors

The Board of Education encourages parents, guardians, and other residents to visit our District's schools. This procedure has been adopted to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the District's students, faculty, and staff.

Upon arrival, a visitor to a District School shall register at the School Office. After signing in at the School Office, the visitor must wear a visible visitor's badge at all times while on school grounds unless escorted by a staff member. If a visitor wishes to observe a particular classroom, that observation needs to be scheduled in advance with the classroom staff and the School Principal or designee.

The School Principal or designee has the authority to prohibit the entry of any person to a school of this District or to expel any person when there is reason to believe the presence of such person would be detrimental to the good order of the school. If such an individual refuses to leave the school grounds or creates a disturbance, the School Principal or designee is authorized to request assistance from the local law enforcement agency.

Michigan's Sex Offenders Registration Act (MCL 28.721, *et seq*) prohibits registered sex offenders from being on school grounds. As such, for the safety and wellbeing of the District's students, faculty and staff, if such a person wishes to visit a District School, the School Principal may impose conditions or prohibit the presence of registered sex offenders as he or she deems reasonable and appropriate.
