

Dear Parents/Guardians of 5th grade students,

We are beginning the process of chromebook signup for 5th grade students.

Wyandotte Public Schools is a 1 to 1 school district, meaning all students from 5th through 12th grade have a chromebook assigned. Students will have the opportunity to use them for learning, educational enrichment and schoolwork at school, home, Bacon Library or any location that has wifi access. Chromebooks will always use Wyandotte's web filtering to block inappropriate content.

Our 5th grade classes started the school year with their new chromebooks in their classroom to use; students will bring home the chromebooks at their teacher's discretion.

Each year parents/guardians will need to complete our district two step signup process.

The two steps include:

- 1. Complete the 5th Grade Online Chromebook Parent Contract that can be electronically signed describing our insurance and acceptable use policy. <u>http://bit.ly/5thgradewps</u>
- 2. Our annual \$25 non-refundable insurance fee paid through MyPaymentsPlus. https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/welcome or http://bit.ly/wpsmypaymentsplus
 - a. The fee is reduced to \$15 for students on a reduced lunch and there will be no cost for students who are on a free lunch For verification purposes, all parents who have children on free or reduced lunch must still register their email contact information on MyPaymentPlus.
 - b. If the Chromebook is damaged, there is a deductible fee that will be applied (see the FAQ).

Parents/Guardians must complete the signup process by November 22, 2019. Our Technology Department will be available on Thursday, November 21st during Parent Teacher Conferences to help you with the signup process and/or answer any questions you may have.
